Carrier Code Template Explanation/Example

Here is an example of a template that has functioned well, assuming that the Ship Days option *is not* used.

CCSSPP where CC=carrier name, SS=service type, PP=payment

An example of creating a carrier record for UPS using Shipping Integrator is UPGRPP where UP represents the carrier name UPS, GR represents a service type of ground, and PA represents Prepaid (add to invoice) payment.

An example of creating a carrier record for a trucking company is ABNOPP where AB represents the carrier name ABF Freight Systems, NO represents no service type since this is not a Shipping Integrator company, and PP represents Prepaid payment.

An example of creating a carrier record for UPS using Shipping Integrator is UPGRP2 where UP represents the carrier name UPS, GR represents a service type of ground, P represents Prepaid payment, and 2 is the number of ship days to be used with the carrier record.

An example of creating a carrier record for a trucking company is ABNOP4 where AB represents the carrier name ABF Freight Systems, NO represents no service type since this is not a Shipping Integrator company, P represents Prepaid payment, and 4 is the number of ship days to be used with the carrier record.
